



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

INTRODUCTION AND CHRONOLOGY OF PROJECT DEVELOPMENT

This project was planned and developed by the Al Hidayah Group (AHG). The project is based on a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed between the Al Hidayah Group (AHG) and D8 Organization for Economic Cooperation on 26th May 2024. Subsequently AHG with D8 Malaysia Foundation intent to collaborates with International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM), Islamic and Science University Malaysia (USIM) and University Malaysia Pahang Sultan Abdullah (UMPSA) to develop "CREATIVE ECONOMY AND FINANCIAL CENTER (CEFC) @ D8 CEFC EDUCATON PROJECT that would draw on education and training developments in economic and business to support the community and the development generally of an educated and knowledge-based society. The development of a business educated society which focuses on Good Islamic Business Practice is seen as critical by the AHG to successfully compete in the new global economic environment.

The AHG leadership shared the vision of the D8 Organization for economic Cooperation and decided to provide technical assistance in the preparation of the project document. It was envisaged that the AHG would fund an aspect of the project and would seek to interest other international development partners in funding other components. It was also envisaged that the project would be funded from contribution from the local and corporate Malaysia.

Following the signing of the MOU, the AHG in collaboration with UIAM, USIM and UPMSA proceeded immediately to prepare a draft feasibility study for a project entitled "CEFC Education Center Project" The project represents the views of both AHG and 3 University in terms of the strategy to address certain specific constraints and needs within the education sector.

On completion of the draft feasibility study, it was shared with the AHG and several other local stakeholders for comments. With funding from the AHG, through a competitive selection process, AHG reviewed and appraised the draft feasibility study and advised on the suitability of the project as planned. This required the Consultants to undertake field work comprising extensive consultation with a range of stakeholders including:

In their field work and consultation exercise, the Consultants sought to get feedback from the various stakeholder groups regarding the proposed project and the design of the various project components. The Consultants presented their findings and recommendations at a meeting of senior directors and technocrats of the AHG. The draft final report was presented to the AHG for comments.

The AHG drew on the findings and recommendations in the final report of CREATIVE ECONOMY AND FINANCIAL CENTER EDUCATON PROJECT, AHG will finalise the comments from the report and D8MF to prepare this final version of the "Feasibility Study on CEFC Education Project." This is therefore the official document that will guide the implementation of the Project.

Introduction

- c. Islamic Gift Economy and Islamic Values




